## SISC III INFORMATION ITEMS JANUARY 20, 2010

- A. **Monthly SISC PPO Claims History Through December 2009.** The SISC PPO claims history through December 2009 will be shown at the meeting.
- B. Show the Board a Summary of SISC's Annual Review of Our Prescription Drug Program. John Stenerson will review this with the Board. Remember there are two parts:
  - The part showing all of the information on everything except the program staff customized.
  - The part showing the program staff customized. It is called the Consumer Share Program.
- C. Show the Board 2010-2011 Plan Savings and Options. John Stenerson will show you these plan savings options we can make available for the 2010-2011 contract year (October 2010).
- D. Mention to the Board the Reason for Bringing out Rates Later. Until last year, rates, for the next fiscal year, have been adopted at the March meeting and based on the trend (inflation factor) from the previous 12 months (Feb. to Feb.). These rates have to fund the program for the next 12 month period from the coming Oct. (known as the window period and is 8 months away) to the following Oct. (20 months away). Once again, with budgets as tight as they are we would like to give the districts ballpark estimates in March but give out actual rates in May because the shorter the window period, the more accurate we can be. We could give out actual Vision, Dental and Life rates but estimates for the Medical and RX.
- E. Update the Board on the "Update on CECHCR Activity" memo. Based on the feedback I received at the last Board Meeting, the "Update on CECHCR Activity" memo was revised. Let's just hold it for the time being. Before it would go out I would bring it back to you.
- F. **Discuss the Annual Board Meeting.** As you are aware, we held this in Bakersfield last year and I received a lot of positive feedback. Additionally, it was a lot less expensive. We know your 2009-2010 budgets aren't any better than last year so we are planning on holding our 2010 Annual Meeting in Bakersfield (May 20 & 21) unless you tell me otherwise.
