SUBJECT: WeTip - 1-800-78-CRIME

SISC has partnered with WeTip, Inc. since September 2013 to provide services related to an Anonymous Hotline that can be utilized by our member districts, students, and community members for the reporting of crimes involving bullying, drugs, arson, burglary, graffiti, guns, vandalism, weapons, or any other crime. This service is available to all member districts.

A liaison person from each district can contact Sue Mandell, WeTip's National Director, at 909-987-5005 at Ext. 250. She will discuss with you the best way to implement the program for your particular district needs in terms of crime resources.

WeTip was established in 1972 and has since expanded to include servicing the entire United States. Anonymous callers can phone information into the WeTip Hotline 24 hours a day 365 days a year. All information is immediately relayed to law enforcement.

- Designed for students and staff members who know about a crime or threat but are afraid to tell anyone.
- School safety hotlines are answered by bilingual tip operators 24 hours a day 365 days a year.
- All calls are anonymous, not just confidential. WeTip has a 100% track record of NEVER having a tipster identified.
- A case number is assigned to the tipster. Tipster may call back and give the case number to add more information to their tip.
- Tipster that are interested in a reward are given a fictitious code name.
- WeTip works hand in hand with law enforcement, school resource officers, members of the school board, school insurance safety and loss specialists, and local media.
