## **Training/Workshop Description**

### **WC/RMS WORKSHOP**

SISC I Workers' Compensation is proud to offer training that will help you understand the Workers' Compensation process and gain tools to reduce claims with the Risk Management Overview. Dealing with a newly reported injury by a district employee can seem daunting, considering the required timeframes and forms that must be adhered to per state law. This workshop will cover all state requirements, providing detailed training on the required forms and the online reporting processes that must be completed in the event of a reportable injury. Your initial actions and compliance are crucial to the timely provision of benefits to your injured employees and the containment of costs for your school district.

### **BBP/IIPP WORKSHOP**

SISC Risk Management Services will be covering the essentials of the Injury and Illness Prevention Program (IIPP) and the Bloodborne Pathogens Program (BBP). If you have already attended this course within the last 3 years, it is not necessary to take the class at this time. Attending it once every 3 years satisfies the SISC annual BBP and IIPP review requirement for SISC I Safety Credits.

**NOTE: Video must be turned on for the entire part of the course to receive credit.**

### **HEAT ILLNESS PREVENTION**

The Heat Illness Prevention Standard (CCR, Title 8, Section 3395) requires all employees and supervisors working outdoors or anyone that may be exposed to high temperatures (indoors or outdoors) to be provided training on heat illness prevention. This training will cover procedures for the provision of water, rest, and shade; different types of heat illnesses, environmental risk factors, weather monitoring, acclimatization methods, training, heat wave, high heat, and emergency response.

### **RETURN-TO-WORK PROGRAM**

This workshop will guide school districts on how to create a successful Return-to-Work Program that will allow employees who are recovering from an injury and unable to perform their regular job duties and responsibilities to work light-duty or in a limited capacity. Establishing an RTW program can help strengthen the relationship between the employer and the employees resulting in increased productivity, teamwork, and the employees feeling valued.
