What should we expect from the Symposium?

Preconference Workshops – Wednesday, November 4th

We will kick-off the Symposium with focused content for those who work closely with the SISC health benefits. SISC staff will be hosting these sessions in a smaller setting to allow for more interactive discussion with attendees. There will be time to connect with your Account Manager and other districts in your region to discuss current employee benefit topics.

Day 1 – Thursday, November 5th:

Day 1 of the Symposium will feature healthcare presentations from industry experts and SISC leadership. Check-in and Symposium registration will take place in the Grand Ballroom Foyer. During this time, you can check into your room and register your attendance with SISC. Please note your room may not be available until 4:00 PM. We will begin with vendor visit time, lunch, and general session. Prizes and opportunities to interact with the sponsors will be included throughout the day. To close out the day, SISC and **Diamond Sponsor American Fidelity** will host a Social Reception on the Lighthouse Courtyard. Appetizers and a hosted bar will be available.

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Day 2 – Friday, November 6th:

Day 2 of the Symposium will continue with healthcare presentations. We will begin with breakfast, followed by the general session. What is the dress code for both Day 1 and Day 2?

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Is parking included in my registration?

Parking for one night is included for those SISC members who are approved for reimbursement by SISC. If SISC is not reimbursing the cost of your room, valet parking is \$34 daily or \$60.00 for overnight parking, and the parking charges will be included on your final hotel bill.

Will the speaker presentations be provided after the event?

The presentations will be available in the weeks following the event if allowed by the speaker. Note-taking materials will be provided.

Can I attend virtually?

The Symposium will be presented only as an in-person event.

HOTEL INFORMATION

How do I book hotel accommodations?

Friendly reminder, it is the attendee's and sponsor's responsibility to book their room. Rooms are available at the contracted group rate, starting at \$319 per night for standard rooms. Please book via the following link: [Hotel Room Reservations](#)

- A credit card is required to book and hold your reservation.
- Your credit card will be charged for your reservation. You can submit for reimbursement following your stay.
- The hotel will also require a credit card at check-in for any incidental charges.

SISC will reimburse for one complimentary night stay and parking for up to two employees per member district. Space is limited, and the reimbursement is only available to those who reserve their room through the SISC booking link at the Symposium hotel **before August 1st or until rooms run out, whichever is earliest.**

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To qualify as a SISC member district, your group must be enrolled in a benefits program through SISC Health Benefits. If you are the employee receiving the complimentary one-night room/parking, you can submit for reimbursement after the Symposium.

HOTEL INFORMATION

What is the reimbursement process?

After the Symposium, you may submit a copy of your final hotel bill for reimbursement for one night stay and parking. The reimbursement is limited to two employees per member district. If more than two employees from a single district request reimbursement, SISC will reach out to those employees to confirm which two should receive the complimentary one-night hotel stay. **The district employees will need to determine who is authorized to receive the one complimentary night stay. Additional details related to the reimbursement process will be provided at the event.**

What if I registered to attend and/or reserved a hotel room but need to cancel?

Hotel Cancellations: Due to our pricing with the hotel, room cancellations are not allowed past November 1, 2026, or 3 days before your arrival date, whichever is earlier. Please notify the Hyatt Regency hotel directly at **(714) 698-1234** to cancel your hotel room reservations and ensure you receive a hotel reservation cancellation number.

Attendees are responsible for any cancellation fees for no-shows or late cancellations. If you do not arrive on your scheduled arrival date or cancel after the deadline, the hotel will charge your credit card a fee equal to your first night's room rate plus tax. Reimbursements will not be provided for no-shows or late cancellations.

Does the hotel have an airport shuttle?

No. The hotel does not have an airport shuttle.

What time is check-in and check-out?

Check-in is at 4:00 PM and check-out is at 11:00 AM. Early check-in is not guaranteed, but the hotel will gladly check you in if your room is ready upon arrival. If your room is not ready, the hotel will let you know when your room is ready. Please check your bags with the front desk to store them until your room is ready.

Where do I take my luggage when I check out of my room?

The Bell Desk will gladly hold your luggage until you depart.

Will I get the same hotel rate if I would like to come early or extend my stay?

Yes, if rooms are available, our group rate is extended 3 days prior and 3 days after.

Are attendees responsible for their own travel costs?

What are the nearby airports?

- Orange County/John Wayne Airport – 12 miles
- Long Beach – 17 miles
- Los Angeles International Airport – 38 miles

Can I take the train and if so which station should I end my route?

Yes, the Amtrak Santa Ana Regional Transportation Center is within 10 miles of the hotel. Another convenient alternative is the Anaheim Regional Transportation Intermodal Center (ARTIC) 11 miles away.

Can I bring a guest?

Travel guests are welcome, but only SISC school district employees and associates are invited to attend the symposium general session and events, including the welcome reception and meals.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Are masks required?

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What are the safety rules?

In order to register for SISC Healthcare Symposium, you must acknowledge, as part of the registration process, that you are aware of the risks of attending a large gathering and that you agree not to sue and hold SISC and its affiliates harmless if you become ill or are injured as a result of attending the SISC Healthcare Symposium or related activities. The Symposium registration form includes a question that indicates your acknowledgment of the risks, agreement to follow health and safety rules, and agreement not to sue and to hold harmless; without confirming agreement with this question, you will be unable to continue the registration process.
